### SOCIAL SCIENCE:

Today the world faces numerous environmental challenges, such as pollution, deforestation and climate change. This calls for the conservation of the environment.

- \* Find out the various environmental challenges faced in both Haryana and Manipur.
- \* Collect information of the various Government as well as non-Government initiative undertaken for environment conservation in both the states.
- \* Compile your findings in an interesting and creative way.

### MATHEMATICS

Collect the temperature data for both states Haryana and Manipur. You can find this information from various sources such as the Oceanic and Atmospheric Weather.

- Decide on a scale to represent the temperature variations. For example, you can use one symbol (such as a thermometer or a sun) to represent a certain range of temperatures, like 10 degrees Celsius.
- Create a table or chart that shows the temperature variations for each state using the symbols.
- Use the symbols you chose in to create a pictograph that represents the temperature variations between the two states. You can use different symbols for each state and arrange them in a way that makes it easy to compare the temperature variations between the two.
